

**MINUTES of the Turf Club Officers Meeting – Sept 1, 2009 (5:00-5:50).** Officers present: Sam Burgess, Trevor Floyd, Adam Leakey, Britt Hendrix, Kyle LeBlanc. Absent: Thomas Aiken and Daryl Jones

1. It was decided that more effort should be made to set definite deadlines for officers and members to complete assigned tasks. Without deadlines, too much time seems to be wasted getting things done.
2. T-Shirts were discussed and Polo Dri-Fit (mesh) shirts seems to be the popular choice with a G and Turfgrass under the G. Color choices were red, white and grey... with Grey or white in the lead as of now. Britt and Kyle will research different vendors and come back to the officers and/or Club members with more information including prices, delivery time, cost, etc. They are to have the information by Sept 8th.
3. It was pointed out that t-shirts and stickers and other items the Club might be selling should be brought to every Turf Club meeting so members would have a chance to purchase these items. In addition, Kyle suggested that we put images and information about the items being sold on the Turf Club Website. This might generate more outside sales.
4. On October 25th-27th the Georgia Golf Course Superintendents Association (GGCSA) Annual Meeting will take place in Stone Mountain. A Vendor Fair will be held on Oct 26 from 11:30 to 3:00pm. The Vendor Fair is where manufactures set up tables and booths showing their products. The Turf Club usually participates in this activity by having a table and selling t-shirts and stickers. It is important that as many members attend this activity as possible. Sam will call the GGCSA for more details and request a space for the Turf Club. This is usually given to the Club free. We hope to have the new shirts by this time so everyone could wear it to the Vendor Fair. Also, Club members should wear their shirts to all Club activities whenever possible. Sam will find out about the Club getting a table and other specifics and report back to the officers/Club as soon as possible.
5. The Golf Course Superintendents Conference and Show (now called the Golf Industry Show, will be held in San Diego, CA, Feb 8-12, 2010. Each year there is a student competition called the Turf Bowl. The Turf Club would like to enter this contest. Sam will get more information and report back to the Club at the next meeting of the Club.
6. The possibility of having each Turf Club meeting on a specific day each month was discussed. The first Tuesday at 5:00 was discussed. This can be discussed further at the next Club meeting.
7. As the Club's primary fund raiser, a long drive contest will be held at the UGA course this Fall. Trevor, Sam and Kyle will contact Dave Cousart (Director of Golf) for permission and suggestions. They will report back to the officers and/or Club as soon as possible.
